On Friday, we will have a moon bounce. *This would be excellent for a couple of our guy members or a husband & wife team.* Youth helpers will be available to assist.
  - **STORYTELLER** - This is a really fun position, as well, and this person will be responsible for telling the Bible Story each evening to all the age groups. There are a few props that I will assist with, and the story is laid out in detail in the booklet. Do you like to tell stories and be blessed by little children learning about Jesus?
  - **ASSEMBLY LEADER** - This person would be in charge of the Assembly at the beginning and end of each evening and direct the youth actors.
  - **TRAIL LEADERS** - This is also a very fun position and entails leading the children in one age group from one activity to another. This would be excellent for anyone who enjoys children and/or a teacher who would like to help.
