The Worship Team will meet at 6 pm on Wed Feb 4. Please join us!

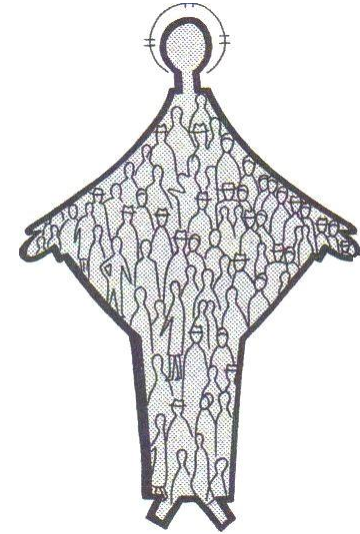
The Thursday Morning Prayer Group will meet at 10 on Feb 5.

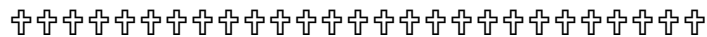

Confession and Pardon
