The 9 am service needs one or two more Power Point Rangers. Please see Gary Indihar or the pastor for more information

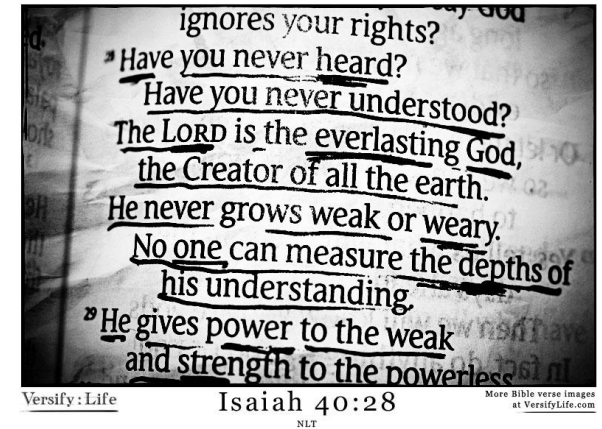
Next Sunday, Feb 15, both services will be held in the white church.

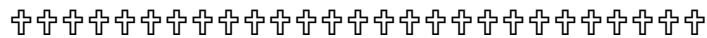
