Thursday Morning Prayer Group will meet at 10 on Nov 19.

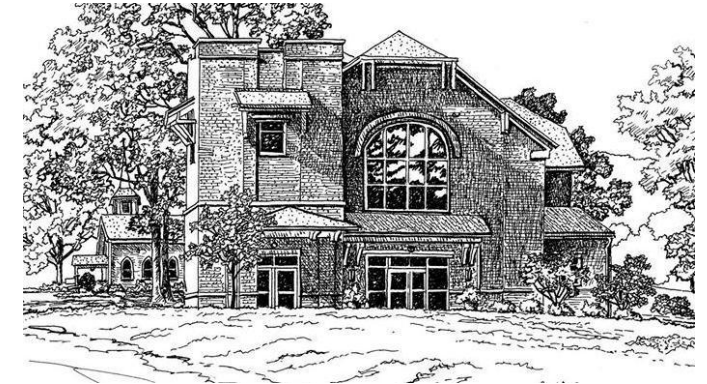
