- **The Big Cove Liturgical Arts Team (LAT)** invite you to join them in a theme of "*The Symbols of Lent.*" If you have a cross that has a special meaning to you (piece of jewelry, framed picture, wood, glass or metal sculpture, wall hanging) please bring it to be displayed on our CROSS TABLE. Please identify your display by placing your name on a note card, and if it has a special meaning, we invite you to share that as well. - **Building Matters:**
 - **When you leave the building** please turn off *ALL BUILDING LIGHTS* except the upstairs front window ones that illuminate the cross. Several recent Monday and Thursday mornings I have arrived at the church to find both sets of lights in the stairwell and some hall lights upstairs or in the downstairs vestibule had been left on.
 - **Also, when you go out via either set of the front double doors**, please don't just let the door fall closed, assuming it is locked, and leave. *Sometimes the door does not fall fully close and latch* unless you go back inside and hit the panic bar another time or two! I have found one of the stairwell double doors ajar—not all the way closed and latched—two or three mornings in the last 2 or 3 weeks. I confess that finding the door this way makes me feel a little vulnerable since I almost invariably arrive here alone. And I think the larger crack between the doors might also force up the heating bill! Thanks! --Mary
