- **Building Matters:**
When you leave the building please turn off **ALL BUILDING LIGHTS** except the upstairs front window ones that illuminate the cross. Several recent Monday and Thursday mornings I have arrived at the church to find both sets of lights in the stairwell and some hall lights upstairs or in the downstairs vestibule had been left on.
FYI-I put the plea above in last week's midweeks, and on 2/15/2016 when I arrived at work, I found two different sets of lights on again. Please check them before you leave—that the chandelier in the stairwell is on is apparently particularly hard to notice! It gets left on often!

OPPORTUNITIES FOR SERVICE:

- **The flower dedication chart has the following vacancies** over the next few months:
