Christian Exploration will meet today for the final time before breaking for the summer.

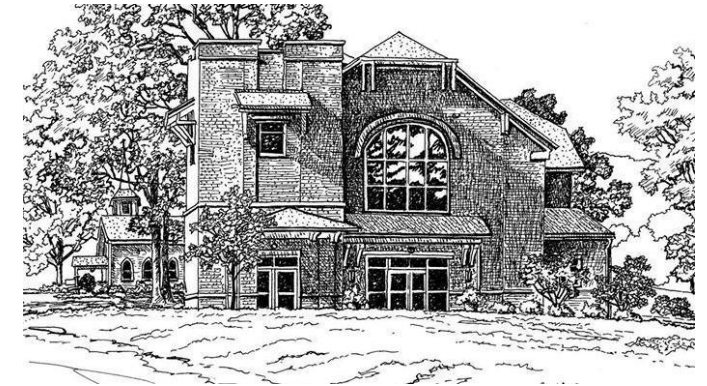
Centering Prayer will meet at 6 Mon (May 23). Kathy is leader.
