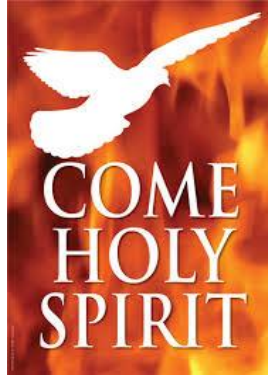

Musician Needed to Lead Contemporary Worship at Presbyterian Church (USA)

The position, which will be open September 1, 2017, requires that the musician select music and, along with the percussionist, accompany the congregation each Sunday at 9:00 a.m. worship service. The musician will coordinate praise music selections with pastor according to the theme/message of worship each week. The service is generally an hour long; occasionally there will be joint services (contemporary and traditional combined) either at 10:00 a.m. or 11:00 a.m. The church is in Big Cove/Hampton Cove area.
